
Similarly, "Star River Tavern" allows characters to relive memories with loved ones, while requiring a balance between love and reality.




## The Recommendation of Film "Inception"


Where is the boundary between dream and reality? This film will take you to explore this question. By interweaving reality and fantasy on each level of the dream, the film shows the contradiction and complexity of the human heart. The dream is considered a fictional space where the characters will not be constrained by reality. For example, the architect can control the environment and characters can fly. In addition, some fantastic scenes like gravity reversal and city folding in the dream can immerse the audience in the impossible world. However, although dreams are fictional, the emotions experienced by the characters in the dreams are deep and real thus projecting feelings and influencing decisions in reality. There is a phantom that Cobb meets with his dead wife and children in his dream, which reveals his deep regret for his wife's death and the hope of seeing his children again. The reconciliation between Robert and his dying father in the dream makes him give up the inheritance of his business company and choose to live his own life. This sense of emotional reality makes dreams and reality coexist in the characters' minds. At the end of the film, the ambiguity makes it difficult for the audience to determine whether Cobb has returned to reality, leaving room for thinking about the boundary between fantasy and reality and blurry the boundary between dream and reality.

Overall, the reason that I recommend this film is that it is not only a profound exploration of the human subconscious but also has a significant theme. It tells us that self-healing is inevitable, but we should learn to accept reality and heal inner scars. Let it go bravely and realize the true self.



# A Twist of Two Loves

Have you ever had the experience of realizing you did not treat your love heartedly before when you are separated from your loved one, and after you two can finally reunite, your loved one almost forgets you? Lu Yanshi, a character in a novel called Lu Fan Yan Shi, The Criminal Lu Yanshi, experienced the same with his wife.

Written by Yan Geling, a famous American-Chinese writer, this novel tells a story that happened during the republic period, the cultural revolution, and the post-reform and openingup period of China. During imprisonment in the north-west of China during the Cultural Revolution, Lu Yanshi gradually realized his love for his wife, Feng Wanyu. After the revolution ended, he returned to Shanghai, where his home is, only to find his wife cannot recognize him with Alzheimer, and his son and daughter loathe him for his absence and affectionlessness to their mother.

Yan adopts different writing techniques such as flashbacks, appearance descriptions, and brilliant psychological descriptions to narrate the emotional changes between Lu Yanshi and Feng Wanyu through several historical periods in China. Recalling the interaction with his wife and how Wanyu expressed her affection implicitly while enduring 20 years of penal servitude, Lu Yanshi was filled with remorse. His love for Wanyu kept building up, and thinking of Wanyu and her love was his spiritual support. Meanwhile, in Shanghai, Wanyu's love for her husband and memory were fading as the years passed by. She failed to reunite with him when she still remembered his look and his favourite food and worried about his well-being.

Yan wrote the love story between Lu and Feng to tell the pity of two lovers who cannot confirm each other's love before their departure and leads readers to think about how huge changes in history affect individuals. For me, I see how a couple and two twists of love intertwine. Lu's dream about seeing his beloved wife and taking care of her was realized, while Wanyu's love for her husband seemingly became a dream, as her thoughts were vaguer and more uncertain because of the disease. However, Wanyu miraculously showed amity towards Lu Yanshi after they reunited, which shows her love for Lu has not disappeared. Their relationship was affected by the changing history, but love is preserved, and it revealed the truth of humanity. This novel, for me, not only tells how uncertainty in our lives leads us to different paths but also guides us to grasp every opportunity in our lives to cherish our loved ones.
