

Grammar Awareness

Second conditional - event that is not real

We use a past tense to talk about a present or future imaginary situation.

If I had money, I would buy a Mercedes-Benz. (I don't have money now)

If I were a man, I would fight for my country. (I am not a man)

	Condition	Result
If	Past simple	Would/should/might/could + original verb

Third conditional - a past event

We use a past perfect to describe a past imaginary situation.

If I had not drunk, I would not have broken my leg. (I was drunk and broke my leg)

If I had apologized, my girlfriend would not have left me.

(I did not apologize and my girlfriend left me)

Condition	Result
If Past perfect	Would/should/might/could + have + past participle

Mixed conditional - the present result of a past condition

We use the mixed conditional to describe a past condition and its probable consequences for the present.

If he had not committed crimes, he would not be in prison now.


(he committed crimes in the past) (he is still in prison now)

If I had worked harder at college, I would have a better job now.

(I did not work hard at college) (I don't have a good job now)







faint (V) To lose consciousness for a short time. 晕厥

hay fever (N) Be allergic to grass or flowers. 花粉症,花粉过敏

horror (N) An extremely unpleasant or frightening experience. 令人感到恐怖的经历

insomnia (N) Difficult to sleep. 失眠症

nutrition (N) The organic process of taking food into the body and absorbing the nutrients in those foods. (吸收)营养

suffer (V) To feel the pain in your body or in your mind. 经受(痛苦)

suicide (V) To kill themselves because they do not want to continue living. 自杀

surgery (N) A medical treatment in which someone's body is cut open so that a doctor can repair, remove, or replace a diseased or damaged part. 手术

terminal (Adj) Describing a stage at which the illness cannot be cured. 晚期的

treasure (V) To care for something carefully because it gives you great pleasure and you think it is very special. 珍惜

(N) A collection of valuable old objects such as gold coins and jewels that has been hidden or lost; valuable objects, especially works of art and items of historical value. 财宝;珍品
