

Zhuhai City Museum

Zhuhai city museum is located in the downtown area,
Jida Jingshan Road. It was built in 1999 and renovated
recently. The museum has 13 exhibition halls with
ceramics, bronzes, paintings, sculpture, handicrafts,
old photos, and details of Zhuhai's history.

The museum sits in a garden with a Chinese classic landscape. A fabulous new museum near Yeli Island is also being built and will be ready in October, 2015.

Qi'ao Island



There are more than 340 beaches in Zhuhai. Even though not all beaches have been developed for tourist use, the local people still love their beaches. The beach in Qi'ao Island is one of the most famous and sublime. You can walk on fine sands, swim in crystal water, and breathe the fresh gentle breezes. It is a great place for swimming,

surfing, and fishing. What's more, there is a reserve in Qi'ao Island for the mangrove wetlands. When it is summer, you can see lots of red crabs moving through the mangrove swamp.

Huafa Shopping Mall

Opened in 2014, Huafa shopping mall is the biggest and newest shopping mall in Zhuhai. It offers an excellent experience in fine dining, shopping, and entertainment. It attracts large numbers of teenagers and students who like to hang around in the cool environment. There are many

Describe events that are will happen in the near future


Rogers and Romanoff are leaving town tonight.

Describe people's habitual behaviors (normally used with *always*, but meaning *often*)

My grandpa is always saying that everything is going to be alright.

Word Awareness

The top left box shows the adjectives to frequently describe physical landscapes. The bottom left box shows how *landscape* is described metaphorically in society. The top right box shows the kinds of professional landscapes that are produced, and the middle box shows the professional people who produce these landscapes. The bottom right box shows different aspects of a landscape.

Words you need to know

- Beach (N) An area of sand sloping down to the water of a sea or lake. 海滩; 沙滩; 湖滩 They do not use sunscreens diligently except during beach vacations.
- **cheap (**Adj) Relatively low in price or charging low prices. 便宜的 Corporations wanted cheap labor in a regulation-free China to build their products and fatten their bottom line.
- clerk (N) An employee whose job is to answer the telephone and deal with people when they arrive.

 职员,接待员 The desk clerk hesitated for a second, but then programmed a keycard and handed it to the policeman.
- Coast (N) The shore of a sea or ocean; the area within view.海岸; 滑坡 Before operation of the railway, transportation between the coast and highland regions was limited.
- downtown (N) The commercial center of a town or city. 闹市区,市中心 About 8,500 people now live in downtown D.C., nearly double the total in 1990.
- expensive (Adj) High in price or charging high prices. 昂贵的 Restaurants in Sao Paulo are more expensive than those in Paris, and office space is pricier there than in New York.
- facility (N) Buildings, equipment or services that are provided for a particular purpose. 设施,设备 But the Indians play in a modern-day facility, which had 455 consecutive sellouts through 2001.
- Island (N) A land mass that is surrounded by water. 岛; 岛屿 As soon as they arrive on the island,
 Italian coast guard ships approach most of the vessels.
- **Magnificent** (Adj) Characterized by grandeur. 壮丽的; 华丽的; 宏伟的 The most magnificent creature in the entire world is human.
- Occasional (Adj) Occurring from time to time; occurring at usually irregular intervals. 偶然的; 临时的 Only occasional cases with exceptionally long incubation periods are still appearing.
- Peaceful (Adj) Not disturbed by strife or turmoil or war; occasions happen without violence or disorder. 宁静的;平静的;和平的 The uprising began a year ago with peaceful protests demanding political reform.
- Plan (N) A series of steps to be carried out or goals to be accomplished; an arrangement scheme. 计划
 One way to develop and set goals is through a professional development plan.
- Plan (V) Have the will and intention to carry out some actions; make plans for something. 计划; 打算
 The government already planned to spend about \$342 million in a new project.

- Remote (Adj) Apart in space. Far away from cities and places where most people live, and are difficult to get to. 遥远的; 偏僻的 There tend to be fewer health care services in more remote areas and a more limited range of job choices.
- **Sightseeing** (N) Going about to look at places of interest. 观光;游览 Lonely Planet covers the most popular sightseeing highlights and local icons
- Sunshine (N) The rays of the sun; moderate weather. 日光; 日照; 晴天 Afternoon sunshine was streaming into the room and Daisy opened her eyes.
- **Travel** (V) Change location; undertake a journey or trip. 旅行; 行进 Length and type of travel and travel behavior are associated with risk.
- **Trip** (N) A journey for some purpose. 旅行 The teacher may provide ideas such as a two-day trip to the city or the local beach to clean the area.
- **twice** (Adv) two times. To double the degree. 两次;两倍 Isolates were tested in triplicate, and the assay was repeated twice.
- vacancy (N) Being unoccupied. An empty area or space. 空房; 空缺; 空白 Evidence of the vacancy rate is never far from sight.
- Visit (V) Visit a place; go to certain places as for sightseeing. 访问; 参观 You also arrange for a local befriending volunteer to come and visit Joan twice a week.
