Jennifer: By the way, the radio said it will rain tonight. Take your umbrella when you are out.


Spencer: Ok. Don't work too hard. See you on Saturday?

Spontaneous decisions

Example: We will have a family meeting tonight at 9 o’clock.

II “be going to” is used for:

Predictions, for when it’s clear now that something is certain in the future

Example: It’s going to rain for a while. Remember to bring an umbrella when you go out.

He is going to buy a bunch of roses for his mother for her birthday.

Fixed plans and decisions

Example: They’re going to watch the premiere of *Captain America* tonight.

I am going to Venice for vacation.



cupcake (n.) : a small light and round cake, often with icing on top 杯形蛋糕 ; 纸托蛋糕

decorate (v.): to put something pretty on an object or place, in order to make it look more attractive 装饰 ; 布置

detail (n.) : the small features of something that you only notice when you look carefully; all the separate features and pieces of information about something 细节 ; 详情

fortnight (n.): a period of two weeks, fourteen days 两星期

grocery (n.): a store that sells food and other things 杂货店

invitation (n.): a written or spoken request to someone, inviting them to go somewhere or do something, or go to an event 邀请

motivation (n.): willingness to do something without being forced to do it 动力 ; 动机 ; 兴趣

possibly (adv.): used when saying something may be true or likely, but you are not completely certain 可能 ; 也许 ; 大概

premiere (n.): the first public performance of a film, play, a piece of music or any other type of entertainment 首映 ; 初次公演

probably (adv.): used to say that something is very likely to happen or very likely to be true 很可能

reject (v.) : to refuse to accept, believe in, or agree with something; to not give someone the love and attention they want and are expecting from you 拒绝 ; 抵制
resident (n.): a person who lives or has their home in a place 居民
suggest (v.) : to tell someone your ideas about what they should do 提议 ; 建议
tonight (n.): during the night of the present day 今晚
